

DECISION OF THE R.T.A. MALAPPURAM dtd 07/04/2010

Item No. 1

Heard. Seek for road fitness. Adjourned

Item No.2

Heard. Regular permit is already granted to the vehicle. Due to serious objections of time clash, timing conference is fixed. The MVI reported that there is no urgent temporary need and hence application for T.P. rejected.

Item No.3

Heard. Objector pointed out that the offered vehicle is covered by valid regular permit and the application is for trafficking. On verification found the vehicle is having regular permit valid from 22.5.2009 to 21.5.2014 and hence the applicant misrepresented this Authority stating that the vehicle is not covered by any regular permit. Hence rejected.

Item No.4

Heard. Seek for road fitness. Adjourned

Item No.5

Heard. The objector pointed out that the vehicle is covered by regular permit. The applicant offered a new vehicle. But the particulars of the vehicle such as wheel base, number of tyres etc., are not furnished. Hence adjourned with direction to the applicant to furnish the particulars of the offered vehicle and provide more trips to the ill served Maruthanchira.

Item No.6

Heard. The representative of KSRTC objected the grant as the route overlap on notified route and over saturated. The Secretary is directed to report the intensity of stage carriage services on the route and the particulars of the offered vehicle such as wheel base and number of tyres. Hence Adjourned.

Item No.7

Heard. The applicant offered the vehicle KL 10R 7354 with wheel base 281.5 cm and 4 wheels covered by a regular permit valid up to 2.4.2012. Hence misrepresented this authority and as per the proceedings of the STA dtd 3/3/2009 (No. D2/391/STA) stage carriage permit shall not be issued, renewed or counter signed to (a) vehicles having wheel base below 306 cm and (b) vehicles having less than 6 wheels. In this case the wheel base is less and the number of wheels 4 only. Hence rejected.

Item No.8

Heard. The objector pointed out that the vehicle offered is covered by regular permit. The applicant submitted an affidavit to produce vehicle if permit granted. But the particulars of the vehicle such as wheel base, number of wheels are not furnished. Hence adjourned with direction to the applicant to furnish the particulars of the vehicle as required by Section 70 & Section 72 of the MV Act 1988.

Item No. 9

Heard. The counsel for the applicant offered the vehicle KL 10W 602. But the vehicle is granted with regular permit and not owned by the applicant. The route applied is circuitous and all trips are operating between well served route Edavanna – Manjeri except for 1 trip to Areacode at off time. The objector pointed out that the applicant not intend to operate the last trip. The representative of the KSRTC objected the grant since the route objectionably overlap on notified route by 5 kms and the route length extended by foul play to violate the provisions of the approved notification G.O. (P) No. 42/Trans/09 dtd 14.7.2009. This authority found that the objections are on genuine ground and hence application rejected.

Item No.10

Heard. The particulars of the vehicle such as wheel base, number of tyres are not furnished. Hence the applicant is directed to furnish the particulars as required by Section 70 & Section 72 of the MV Act 1988. The Secretary is directed to seek for road fitness certificate. Adjourned.

Item No.11.

Heard. The offered vehicle is having only 4 wheels. As per the decision of the STA dtd 3/3/2009 (No. D2/391/STA/09) stage carriage permit shall not be issued to vehicles having less than 6 wheels. All the trips are between the saturated Kuttippuram – Valanchery except for two single trips. Hence, rejected.

Item No.12

Heard. The counsel for the applicant offered vehicle No. KL 10X 8892. But the vehicle is covered by regular permit. The objector pointed out that the running time between Alloor and Patternadakkavu (20 minutes) is not in parity with other services on the route. Hence adjourned with direction to the applicant to rectify the defects.

Item No.13

Applicant absent. Adjourned.

Item No.14

Petitioner absent. Adjourned with direction to the Secretary to send show cause notice to the conductor and permit holder to suspend the C.L and permit respectively.

Item No. 15

Parties not appeared. Adjourned with direction to the Secretary to send notices to the concerned parties.

Heard. The Jt. RTO Tirur and Perinthalmanna reported that there exists no vacancy of A/R permits and there is no necessity for issuing additional parking place since over saturated with A/Rs. However on 21.1/2010 this authority granted permit to only 1 applicant since the permit holder bought his vehicle under PMRY scheme. Now the other applicants also produced certificates to the effect that they are also beneficiaries of PMRY scheme. At this juncture, this Authority decided to grant permit to the 5 applicants also. No application for parking place for A/Rs at Tirur and Perinthalmanna shall be entertained hereafter.
